1 Background & Introduction

The **PMP** credential validates project leadership experience and expertise, supercharges careers across industries, and significantly enhances the credentials, marketability and employability of project management professionals. The **Project Management Professional (PMP)®**, offered by the **Project Management Institute (PMI)**, is the world's leading project management certification. It is accredited against the internationally recognized **ISO/ANSI 17024** and **ISO 9001** standards. **ESAMI Business School**, in partnership with **Project Management Zimbabwe (PMZ)** — a PMI Authorized Training Partner — offers a three-week intensive online preparatory programme that equips participants to sit and pass the PMP certification examination

2 Programme Structure

Built directly on the PMP Examination content, the programme covers the three examination domains of People (33%), Process (41%) and Business Environment (26%), across predictive, agile and hybrid ways of working, while providing the 35 contact hours of formal project management training required for full PMP eligibility.

The programme runs over three intensive weeks, with each week dedicated to one of the three domains of the PMP Examination content. The key topics in each domain form the modules covered during that week as indicated below.

3 Mode of Delivery

The programme is delivered online through virtual live classes, conducted by expert PMP-certified facilitators from Monday to Friday, 17:00hrs – 22:00hrs, allowing participants to learn without interrupting their working day. Live sessions are complemented by recorded content for revision, practice questions and mock examinations. Participants who complete the programme will earn the 35 PMI contact hours required for PMP examination eligibility.

4 Examinations

The PMP certification examination is administered by PMI and comprises 180 questions (170 scored and 10 unscored pretest questions) to be completed in 240 minutes, with two 10-minute breaks. Question formats include multiple-choice, multiple-response, matching, drag-and-drop, point-and-click, case/scenario-based and graphic-based questions. The examination will take online with a proctor. Candidates may attempt the examination up to three times within their one-year eligibility period. The PMI examination will be taken one week after the last class, giving participants a dedicated week for revision and examination preparation.

5 Eligibility

The programme is primarily designed for ESAMI MPM graduates and MPM students in their final year of study. Admission is also open to other ESAMI Business School alumni and individual professionals with equivalent qualifications from other institutions of higher learning. Applicants outside these criteria who apply on a group or corporate arrangement are welcome to apply, subject to a separate fees structure, availed on a need basis. To sit the PMP examination, candidates must additionally satisfy at least one of the PMI's eligibility paths;

- A secondary school diploma (or equivalent) with a minimum of 60 months (5 years) of non-overlapping experience leading projects; or
- An associate's degree, higher certificate or advanced technical/vocational qualification with a minimum of 48 months (4 years) of experience leading projects; or
- A bachelor's degree (or higher) with a minimum of 36 months (3 years) of experience leading projects; or
- A bachelor's or postgraduate degree from a PMI GAC-accredited programme with a minimum of 24 months (2 years) of experience leading projects.

All candidates also require 35 hours of project management training - fully provided by this programme.



6 Application Procedure

Applicants register through the online registration link <https://forms.office.com/r/g9WZJtTAtf>. Upon successful registration, applicants receive an official admission letter from ESAMI Business School confirming their place in the cohort.

7 Fees

The programme fee covers tuition, learning materials, practice examinations and the PMI examination fee. **ESAMI** alumni and students currently enjoy a 25% discount, subject to review when need arises.

- Upon admission, payment may be made in two instalments, both completed before the start of the programme.
